Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

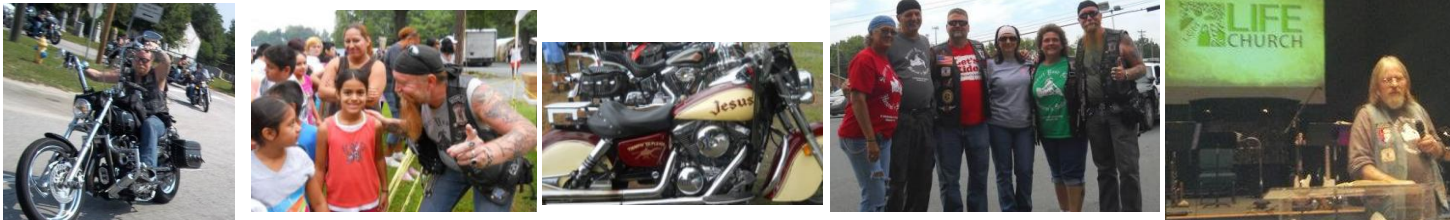

100% sure and he excitedly said yes! We prayed the sinner's prayer together right there at track side and he accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior! Glory to God! I'm looking forward to seeing another brother in heaven some glorious day.

Stay sensitive to the Holy Spirit. You never know when the Lord may give you the opportunity to lead a soul to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ, or if you may be the person that plants the seed so they are open to receive. The man had obviously heard the Gospel since he was going to church, but it took a supernatural encounter in God's perfect timing to bring him to salvation.
